

What is JSTOR?

JSTOR provides access to the contents of 150 journal titles dedicated to scholarly research and theory in the fields of language and literature, as well as important titles in the fields of music, film studies, folklore, performing arts, religion, and the history and study of art and architecture.


1. How can I access it?

- In Internet Explorer, type in the address below:

<http://www.jstor.org>

- If you are accessing this resource from outside the College, click on 'Login' in the top-right hand corner of the screen, then choose 'United Kingdom' as your country and 'Hull College Group – Shibboleth' as your institution. Log in using your College network username and password.

2. Searching

- From the home page, type in the keywords you are looking for in the search box and click on .
- Your search results will then be displayed in order of relevance. Use the drop-down menu to sort your results by date instead.
- Click on the PDF link beneath the article title to view its contents.
- The journal article will then be displayed as .pdf file, and can be saved or printed as usual.

3. Advanced searching

- Click on the Search tab near the top of the page, and choose Advanced Search from the menu.
- In Advanced Search there are various options, for example you can search within a specific journal or narrow your search by date.

Browsing

- You can also browse through the contents of specific journals. Click on the Browse tab near the top of the page, and choose an option. You can browse by discipline, title or publisher.
- You will be taken to a list of journals, sorted either by discipline, title or publisher depending on which option you chose. Click on a journal title to see which volumes of that journal are available for browsing.
