How can I access it?

- In Internet Explorer, type in the address below:

- You will need a **username** and **password** if you are accessing this resource from a non-College computer (available from a member of library staff)
- Click anywhere on the introductory screen

Country information

- To find information about the 18 main countries or the EU as an organization, click on the appropriate flag at the bottom of the screen



- To find information on the other 39 countries, click on 
- The main countries have 18 sections of information, the others may have less.
- Click on the picture to choose a section and then on one of the topics listed to choose a subsection.



- Use the blue arrows at the top to move through the information in that section.



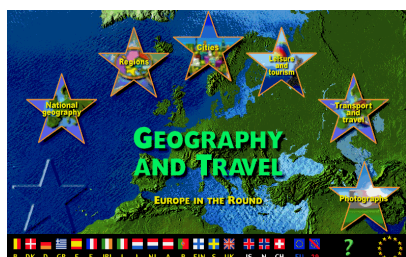
Searching by topic

- To search for information on a topic click on the appropriate star on the main screen
- The four areas are:

- Business and work
- Study and research
- People and society
- Geography and travel



- Each topic will then show you a page of topics to choose from



- You are then given a map showing the flags of those countries where there is information on that topic.
- If you want information on a topic across the EU, begin by clicking on the EU flag.



Comparisons

- For certain statistics you can compare those of one country to those of another.
- Look up the statistics of the first country, for example UK population
- Then click on the Comparison button in the top right hand corner and choose the country you want to compare it with.
- You will then be given a table showing the 2 sets of data side by side
- You can also click on the Excel button to see the data in Excel. You can save the data in Excel to use in your own work.
