

What is Film & Sound OnLine?

Film & Sound OnLine is a set of collections of film and video. Several hundred hours of high-quality material are available for download, either in full or as segments, and can be used freely in learning, teaching and research.

Collections include footage from the Imperial War Museum, the Anglia Television Library, the Biochemical Society and Performance Shakespeare.

1. How can I access it?



- Type the words you want to search for in the search box provided:





Downloading

- Clicking on the title of film takes you to a detailed synopsis. Long films are divided into segments – you can choose to download a segment or the entire film.

Segment 1: Channel Four series title: People to People. City housetops and shots of Byker. A voice over explains that though slum clearance breaks up long-standing communities it may also have the benefit of breaking up groups of people with "no initiative or civic pride, even though the people seem to be satisfied with their miserable environment and seem to enjoy an extrovert social life." The quote is attributed to Wilfred Burns, city planning officer in Newcastle, 1963. Konttinen explains that she arrived in 1969 and spent ten years documenting the changing area. Women's voices give a range of reactions to her arrival. Film of shoppers and a shot of a shop outside which records are played on a wind up gramophone.

- Click on **Download Segment** or **Download Film**. You will then be taken to a download page. Films can be downloaded as Windows Media or Quicktime files. Click on the option you want with your right-hand mouse button and choose 'Save As'. The file will then be downloaded to the location of your choice. We suggest you use the **FTP Download** options as they appear to be more reliable.
- Remember to read carefully the section in red on the download page that starts 'Please Note'. This tells what you can and cannot do with the material you have just downloaded.
