

### What is Know UK?

KnowUK is a web service that provides key information about the people, institutions and organisations of the United Kingdom. It is unique in that it draws together the principal UK reference sources and makes them cross-searchable.

KnowUK contains:

- biographical information
- an advice database for UK citizens
- information on organisations and associations
- information on schools, colleges and universities
- information on courses, careers and qualifications;
- information on national and local government,
- information on a range of health matters.
- information on libraries museums, galleries and associations.
- information on a range of common legal problems
- overview of the religious make-up and inter-faith activity of the UK
- recommended hotels, B&Bs, restaurants and pubs
- a National Events Calendar

### To View your results

- When you search for the information you want, you are given a list of results
- These are ranked by relevance, according to how closely they match your search terms. You can change this order to alphabetical or pick one of the categories of results from the left hand column
- To read the full text of one of the listed results, click on the title.

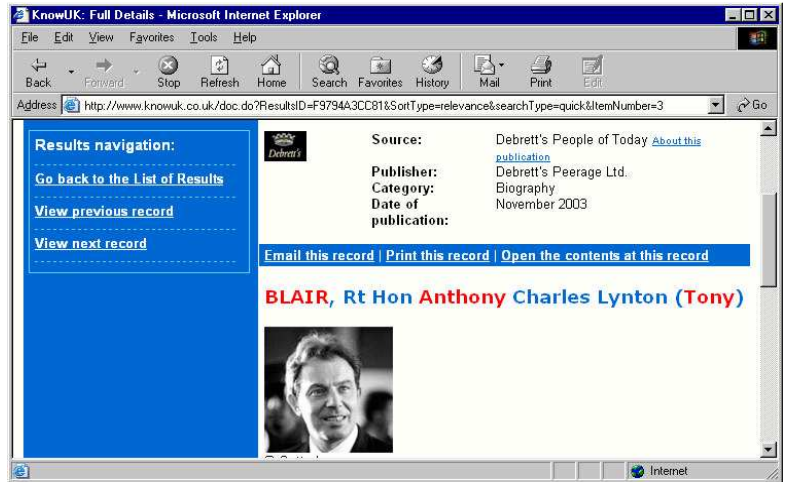

- The Full Details show you which publication this information is from. The words you searched on are in red.
- From this screen you can choose to e-mail the information to yourself, print it, or see the contents page of the publication.
- You can use the links in the left hand column to move to the previous or next record or back to the list of results.



## Advanced Searching

- To reach the advanced search screen, click on **Advanced Search** on the Home page
- From here you can choose from 3 types of search:

### All of these terms

Uses AND to link the words  
e.g. Shakespeare and poetry

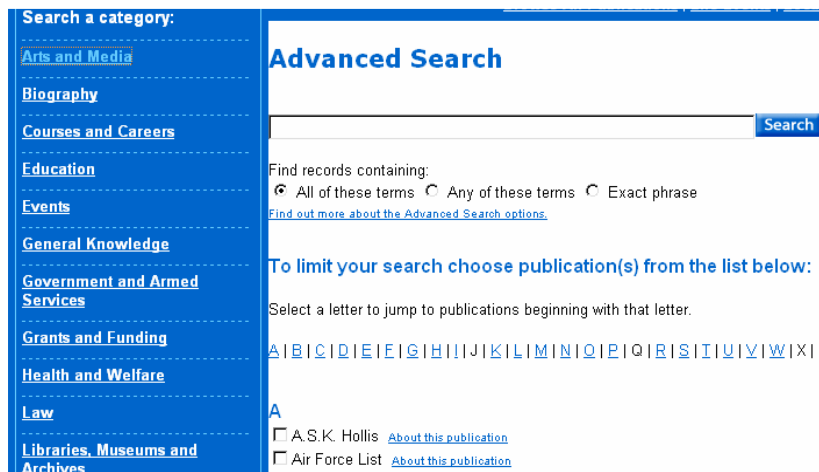
### Any of these terms

Uses OR to link the words e.g. cookery, cooking will find articles with either term in.

### Exact phrase

Searches for an exact phrase e.g. pop art

- The tick boxes below allow you to restrict your search to one or more certain publications
- You can use the category list at the left hand side to choose to search just one category.



- Click on the **Search** button and a list of results will appear, as it did before.

## Searching tips

- All searches will find plurals and different forms of words e.g. browse, browsing  
Only the Quick Search option will offer you alternative spellings if you misspell a word.
- The **Local Information** option on the Home page will help you find maps & images, information on local services and links to websites of local organisations.
- The **Browse all Publications** option on the Home page lets you browse through each publication as you would through the printed version.
- The **Life events** option on the Home page links to information on major life events such as birth, death, marriage etc.
