### What is World Book Online?

World Book Online provides access to the contents of The World Book Encyclopaedia, as well as related images, audio and video clips.

World Book Online also includes a Dictionary and Atlas, and resources relating to current news stories.

#### 1. How can I access it?


- In Internet Explorer, type in the address below:

- Type in the user name and password to continue - ask at the Library desk for these.

#### 2. Searching


- Type the words you want to search for in the search text box:

- Click on the title of an article to read its contents If you wish to view your search results within the other categories such as Maps, Pictures or Videos and Animations, click on the appropriate category title.
- Clicking on [Print Full Article](#) will take you a printer-friendly version of that article.
- Clicking on [E-Mail Article](#) will give you the option to email somebody a copy of the article.
- At the bottom of each article is a suggestion as to how you might acknowledge your source if you quote from the article in your coursework.
- Tip: double click on any word within an article to be taken to its dictionary definition.

## Advanced Search and Browse

- Click on the [Advanced Search](#) link next to the Search text box to go to the Advanced Search page:

- From here you can choose specific categories to search or Browse within. For example, tick the 'Pictures' box if you only want to search for pictures.
